How to Build Your Local Organization

Adapted from *Keys to Adventist Community Services*

Experienced community service leaders have found that there are a number of important sequential steps in building a viable organization. These steps may need to be scaled according to your church or program size. If you follow the steps outlined here, you will assure your program the best opportunity for success.



- 1 Form a joint planning committee with other Adventist churches in the area.** Church pastors and key lay leaders from each Adventist church in your city or rural area should be invited to meet together to plan and oversee the development of a program. The mobilization of resources from more than one church multiplies the impact that can be made within an area.
- 2 Agree on someone to serve as project leader.** This should be someone who has training in leadership.
- 3 Conduct a comprehensive community needs assessment.** It is impossible to know the needs of a community without careful study. A proper needs assessment will reveal a detailed picture of the community, its people, neighborhoods, social problems, felt needs, and resources.
- 4 Officially organize.** Whether your organization will be a local unit/department, center, or agency, it must be officially established by the church board or the boards of sponsoring churches. A date should be established for a meeting to approve a constitution and by-laws and elect a group of people to serve as the organization's board.
- 5 The new board should begin to meet immediately.** Immediate items on the board agenda include: what services to provide, appointing a director, and which site and which facilities will be used for the operation.
- 6 Develop the program.** Develop program plans that outline in detail the services provided, the necessary personnel and budget, and the schedule for implementing services.
- 7 Develop a support base for your agency.** Find church members who believe in, and take interest in, the center, who pray regularly for its success, and tell others about its impact.
- 8 Start fundraising.** Sources of funding include grants, contracts, online campaigns, direct mail appeals, special offerings, special events, and deferred giving through wills, trusts, and bequests. Successful fundraising takes a great deal of effort over a long period of time.
- 9 Begin to recruit and train volunteers.** Recruit and train volunteers needed to deliver the services planned. Potential volunteers include church members, students, and organized groups such as Sabbath School classes.
- 10 Conduct a major kick-off event.** It must include an opportunity to invite the entire community, including important civic leaders such as the mayor or local legislator. Be sure to also include the local news media.
- 11 Plan a retreat with the board after the first year.** After the first year of operations it is important to devote quality time for evaluation and long-range planning. It will also be time for a careful reflection on scripture and the mission God has given your ministry, allowing quality time for praying together, seeking God's guidance.






Burst the Bubble

Disaster Response

The Adventist Community Services Disaster Response (ACSDR) ministry stands ready to serve the survivors of disasters. It operates with a Statement of Understanding with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), the American Red Cross, and many state emergency management agencies.

ACSDR provides support through:



Community Collection Centers — ACSDR works with community organizations and the general public to gather donated goods when emergency needs exist. Items such as food, blankets, personal care kits, baby care items, cleaning supplies, and new clothing are accepted and processed for distribution by ACSDR.

Emergency Distribution Centers — Donated goods that have been processed by ACSDR may be provided to meet the immediate needs of families. Emergency distribution centers are often based in community facilities, such as high school gyms, church halls, vacant store fronts, or vacant lots.

Multi-agency Warehouses — This is a facility where unsolicited donations can be brought and made available to emergency distribution centers. This process provides a steady supply of goods ready for distribution.

Mobile Distribution Units — Mobile distribution is used to deliver goods into areas that may have been cut off during a disaster or where no other services are being provided. These areas may have been made inaccessible for a period of time due to high water, downed trees, or bridges out. The survivors may not have transportation, or the ability to leave their homes or neighborhoods.
