

Family Helper

1. Read and discuss the following Bible verses.
 - a. Philippians 2:14
 - b. John 15:12
 - c. Hebrews 13:16
 - d. Galatians 6:9
2. Who is a family helper?
3. Discuss things you can do to be a family helper.
4. Keep a log for three weeks listing how you have been a helper.
 - a. Each week discuss with your mentor the progress you have made that week.
 - b. Discuss the ways you have helped and which was your favorite.
 - c. Discuss what ways you could have helped differently.
5. Make a thank you card/note for a family member to thank them for everything they do to be a family helper.



Helps

1. After reading each verse, ask the children for examples of how they can apply the verses in their lives.
2. Show pictures of family members doing different activities and have the children explain why the person is a family helper. Your public library or the internet is a great resource for family helper pictures or you could take pictures of the Adventurers and their families doing helpful activities.
3. Have the children draw an activity or action (being agreeable or cheerful) from a container. Then have them act out the activity or action for the other children to guess.
