1. A piñata is a container often made into different shapes from paper-mâché, pottery, or cloth, that is decorated, filled with candy, and then broken as part of a celebration.
2. Piñatas have many shapes, sizes, colors, but what really counts is what is on the inside.
3. It's especially popular at birthday parties and is also used to mark special occasions, such as Christmas, fairs, and festivals.
